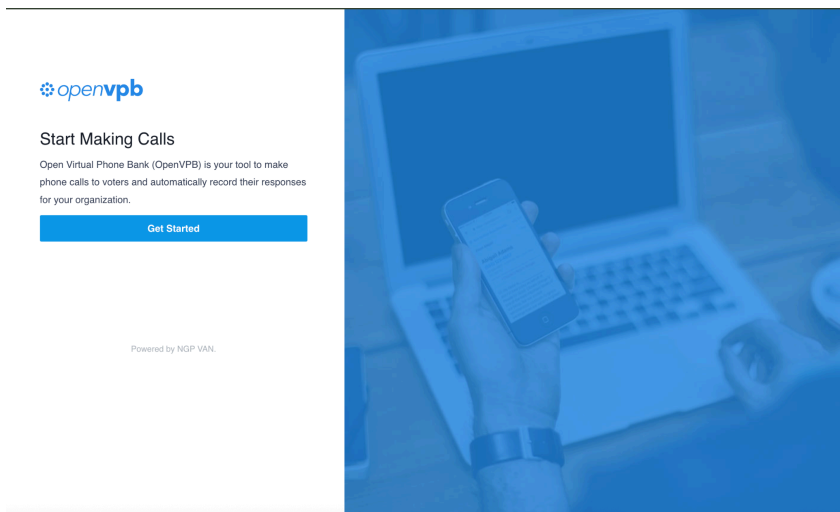
How to Phonebank with GSV

What is Phone Banking?

- At this point in the campaign, this is who we are talking to:
 - ◆ We have created a list of targeted voters: persuadable Independents and low turn out Democrats who we reach out to **by the phones** in order to identify our voters and create a plan to vote as we get closer to Election Day.
- In person and phone call conversations with a voter increase the likelihood of the voter turning out for Election Day
- New Hampshire has a history of *extremely close* races:
 - ◆ Bobbi Boundman won her race by 165 votes. Corinne Casscaden lost her special election by 5 votes. Those are what we call field margins which means that we can win or lose based on the number of in person conversations that we have.
 - ◆ In 2016 Maggie Hassan won her senate seat by 1,017 votes
- Become a regular! We have phonebanking multiple times a week and the more you dial, the better and more fun it gets!

How to Use Open VPB

1. Open the link the organizer sends you. You'll get this page



2. If this is the first time you've made calls with us you'll need to create an account. If you've canvassed using MiniVAN, you will use the same log in as that app

Not Home: No one picked up or someone who isn't the listed voter picked up and said that they were not home

Refused: The voter asked to be taken off the list

Deceased: The voter died

Moved: The voter no longer lives in New Hampshire (still ask questions even if they live in a different part of the state!)

Call Back: Voter unable to talk at that time and requests someone try again later

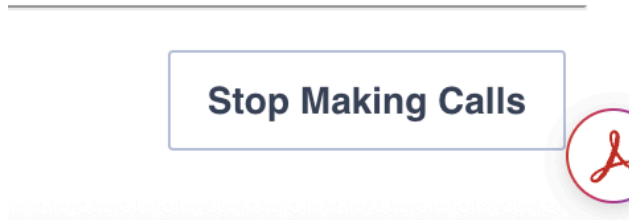
Busy: Phone gives busy signal

Left Message: Ignore we will not be leaving messages to voters at this time

Wrong Number: The number we have for the voter is incorrect and the owner of the phone tells you this

Disconnected: The number is no longer in service

9. Once you are done with your call session you'll use the "Stop Making Calls" button on the bottom right of the screen.

Cinde Warmington is a health care advocate who served on our state's Executive Council, where she held the Governor accountable for wasteful spending while working to improve public schools, expand job development, and build affordable housing. As Governor, Cinde will end the cycle of corrupt governance, cut fees that target working people, and build an economy that works for everyone, not just the wealthy and well-connected.

Here in New Hampshire, all of our state races are on the ballot in November, including Governor, State Senate, State House, and Executive Council. For the last eight years, Republicans have held all of these chambers, and have used that power to defund public schools and force your property taxes to go up.
